Mr. Cusic's secretary, Mrs. Everette, is a devoted member of the office staff. Her cheerful personality adds greatly to the school's atmosphere.

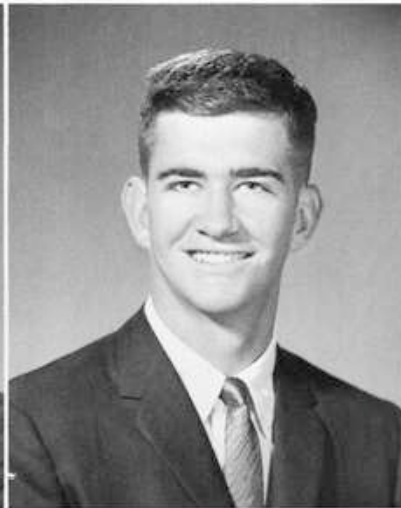
